PAYMENT


For a single working parent living in **Montgomery County**, working full-time, making minimum wage (\$12.00 per hour) and with an infant in child care they would either pay:

50% of their income before taxes, if their child was in a child care center.

36% of their income before taxes, if their child was in a child care home.

* \$12.00 per hour x 40 hours = \$480 per week before taxes *

Problems Finding Care

Follow ups were completed on **71** out of the **327** families (representing **108** out of **498** children) who contacted Community Child Care Connection for child care referrals during the fiscal year of 07/01/2021 through 06/30/2022.

The most common problems in searching for care as reported by the **71** families with follow ups:

- No openings: 49
- Not problems reported: 13
- Other: 13
- Location: 6
- Schedule: 6
- Cost: 4
- Provider not experienced in child needs: 3
- Quality: 2
- Provider not trained to meet child needs: 2
- Curriculum: 1
- Provider could not accommodate child: 1
